WHEREAS, I, the said J. A. B. Caughman
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of

in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred and 75/100
Dollars, to be paid on the 20th day of July 1922

with interest thereon from the day of July 1922 at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

the percentage in whole amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said J. A. B. Caughman
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rev. C. Luther Miller,

his heirs and assigns forever; all that certain piece, parcel
or lots of land situated lying and being in Ward Six of
the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having
the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made
by R. C. Dalton to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of University
Street joint corner of lots nos. 3 and 4 and running thence
with line of University Street S. 50 E. 52 feet to an iron pin
joint corner of lots nos 4 and 5 thence with line of lot
No. 5 S 37.57 W 124.4 feet to an iron pin on J. A. Cureton's
line, thence with line of said Cureton N. 53.58 W 51 feet
to an iron pin joint corner of lots nos 3 and 4 thence
with line of lot No. 3 N 37.29 E. 127.6 feet to the beginning
corner and being lot No. 4 as shown on plat above referred
to, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by
W. D. Workman by deed dated Aug 25th 1919 which
