a corporation, its successors and assigns, All those certain
pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in
Greenville Township about two and one-half miles north-
west of Greenville Courthouse, including lots one and two,
nearly all of lot twenty and the east part of lot five on plat
recorded in Plat Book E, at page 245; and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit: -
Beginning at a stake on the west or southwest corner of
Green Street and the Buncombe Road, and running thence
along said Buncombe Road N. 57-18 W. 258 feet to a stake
on the corner of lot No. 3; thence along line of last
mentioned lot and continuing beyond said line in the
same direction S. 32-40 W. 230.8 feet, more or less, to a stake
inside of lot No. 5, ten feet from the boundary line of lot No. 6,
