Dollars, to be paid on or by the fifteenth of October 1922

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said V.M. Babb his heirs and assigns

All my right title and interest in all that certain piece
parcel or tract of land lying being and situate in the County
of Greenville, State aforesaid, containing 87 acres more or less,
this being the same tract of land conveyed to my father,
Jesse Goldsmith, by deed of C.H. Judson, said deed
being recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County
in Deed Book 66 at page 237 to which reference is
made for a description as to lines, corners, distances, etc.
my interest therein being conveyed to me as one of the
heirs at law of Jesse Goldsmith deceased and being said
undivided part thereof. It is understood and the intention
is that this mortgage covers and further interest that I may
inherit or acquire in the foregoing described tract of land
bounded by lands of J.B. Jones estate, D.D. Goldsmith,
Robert Boykin et al.
