in the full and just sum of Five thousand & no/100 (\$5,000.00)  
Dollars, to be paid one year from date, with privilege of anticipating any part or the whole  
of said sum at any time before maturity

with interest thereon from January 1st, 1922 at the rate of 10% per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid

and unpaid; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.P. McGee and C.M. McGee, Trustees, All that certain

piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying in the County and State aforesaid, City  
of Greenville in Ward Six of said City, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4,  
on a plat of the estate of Mrs. N.E. Harris made by W.D. Neves, October 22nd, 1913, and  
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book C, page 261. Said  
lot fronting on Augusta Street 60 feet with said lines of 170 feet and 160 feet  
respectively and a width of 57 feet on the back line; this being the same lot of land  
conveyed to R.B. Wilson and H.B. Dantzler by Mrs. E.G. Hester by deed dated February  
20th, 1920, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 57, page  
637, and being the same lot conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master by deed dated January 30th,
