until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Ten Per Cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount on note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. N. Townes, Attorney for Mrs. M. B. Rudd

his heirs and assigns, all piece, parcel or lot of
land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, about two miles from Greenville
Court house in the subdivision known as Puddledox
Heights and shown on plat made by W. D. Neves, Dec-
ember 1912, and known as Lot No 12 on said plat
and having the following metes and bounds.
Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Gen-
try Street 625 feet from the north side of the Puddledox
Road and running thence with Gentry Street in a
northeasterly direction 50 feet to an iron pin; thence
with the line of lot No. 14 in north westerly direction
150 feet to an iron pin; thence in a southwesterly
direction parallel with Gentry Street 50 feet to an iron
pin, and thence in a southwesterly direction with
