computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten Per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. R. Hunter and his heirs and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land bounded by lands
of A. G. Sloan, P. D. Hunter, C. E. Mayfield, M. H. Sloan and others
and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning
at a stone on P. D. Hunters line and running thence N. 55 1/2
E. 1445 ft to a stake on P. D. Hunters line; thence N. 39 1/4 W. 1028
feet to a stake 3x; thence S. 11 1/2 W. 1094 feet to a stake in
center of Georgia Road; thence with said road S. 88 W. 527 feet to
a stake 3x in center of road G. A. Sloan line, thence S. 14 E.
341 feet to a stone 3x; thence S. 31 1/2 E. 230 feet the beginning
corner, and containing eighteen acres, more or less.
