Dollars, to be paid one year after

with interest thereon from date annually at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually until in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of principal and interest by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Franklin Smith
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John T. Woodside, All that piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina,
and being known and designated as Lot number sixty-three (63) of the property of the
Overbrook Land Company, according to a plat and survey of said property which is of
record in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, South
Carolina in plat book E., at page 261, said lot of land having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at corner of lot number sixty-two of the aforesaid plat and
running thence with Overbrook Road South 84 degrees 2 min. West fifty feet to an iron
pin; thence with said road South 78 degrees 23 min. West fifty feet to an iron pin;
thence still with said road South 51 degrees 49 min. West thirty feet to an iron pin;
thence with Overbrook Circle South 32 degrees 11 min. West fifty feet to an iron pin;
thence continuing with Overbrook Circle South 29 degrees 25 min. West sixty-six and
7/10 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot number sixty-four of said plat; thence with
the line of said Lot number sixty-four South 76 degrees 47 min. East one hundred
forty-six and 4/10 feet to an iron pin, the corner of lot number sixty-two of said
plat; thence with the line of said lot number sixty-two North 13 degrees 13 min.
East one hundred seventy-two and 7/10 feet to the beginning corner.
