computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B.M. McGee, his heirs and assigns, All that certain lot or
parcel of land in the State & County aforesaid in ward two of the City of Greenville, on the
West Side of Rowley Street, being known as the Southern half of lot 36 of plat J.E. Serrine
fronting on Rowley Street 52-1/2 feet and running back 210 feet deep, being all the lot
conveyed to me by James Angel June 27th, 1917 by deed duly recorded in R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Vol. 44, page 117.
