until paid in full. All interest not paid when due to be added to the principal and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of principal and interest to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note, and pay for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

Town of Greer, or near the line of the City limits, and being the same lot conveyed to me  
by J.C. Bright, and bounded by lands of Walker Smith, on East and Alley on the South and
