

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, G. P. Bishop, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said G. P. Bishop in and by my certain bond or obligation, bearing date the 23rd day of October 1920, stand firmly held and bound unto THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the penal sum of Thirty four Hundred and 20/100 (\$3,400.00) Dollars, conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of Seventeen Hundred and 20/100 (\$1,700.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 23rd day of October A. D. 1920 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of said Company, in manner and form the following, that is to say, that the said G. P. Bishop shall pay, or cause to be paid, to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th day, or before the end of the month of October 1920, and on the 20th, or before the end of each month thereafter, for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty eight and 33/100 (\$28.33) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the 2 substituted shares of stock, and 600 shares of 33/100 (\$11.33) Dollars being the monthly interest on the advance or loan), until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seventy seven and 7/100 (\$77.14) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 700 shares of 7/100 (\$9.14) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of 17 and 54/100 (\$17.54) Dollars,

Dollars being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 500 shares of 33/100 (\$16.67) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of 17 and 54/100 (\$17.54) Dollars,

being the monthly payment of said shares of stock and 400 shares of 33/100 (\$13.33) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of 17 and 54/100 (\$17.54) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 300 shares of 33/100 (\$10.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due).

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th, or before the last day, of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 300 shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid on the said shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said G. P. Bishop and shall pay or cause to be paid, all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said G. P. Bishop

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said bond or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said G. P. Bishop in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said bond or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to the said G. P. Bishop in hand well and truly paid by the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Situate, lying and being about two miles West Greenville County Court House land being a portion of property known as City View, and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on Henderson Street 200 feet from Summit Street joint corner of Lots 54 and 55 and running thence N. 0. 30 E. with line of Henderson Street 100 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 56 and 57, thence in an easterly direction with line of Lot 56 and 57, 150 feet to a stake; thence in a southerly direction 100 feet to a stake, thence in a westerly direction 150 feet to beginning, being known and designated as Lot nos. 55 and 56 in Block A according to a plat made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, of record in W.P.M.C. office for Greenville County and being the same lot conveyed to me by W. J. Henderson, J. F. Hunt and H. W. Hunt by deed dated August 7th, 1917, and recorded in Volume 46, page 426, W.P.M.C. office for Greenville County.
