

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, J. H. Meadors, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said J. H. Meadors in and by my certain bond or obligation, bearing date the 8th day of May, 1922, stand firmly held and bound unto THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the penal sum of Two Thousand & no/100 (\$2,000.00)

conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of One Thousand & no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 8th day of May

A. D. 1922 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of said Company, in manner and form the following, that is to say, that the said J. H. Meadors shall pay, or cause to be paid, to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors, or assigns of Greenville S.C. aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th day, or before the end of the month of May 1922, and on the 20th, or before the end of each month thereafter, for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty six & 67/100 (\$26.67) Dollars (20.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the Twenty shares of stock, and six & 67/100 (\$6.67) Dollars

being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty four & 33/100 (\$24.33) Dollars (20.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and four & 33/100 (\$4.33) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty-four & no/100 (24.00) Dollars,

20.00 Dollars being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & no/100 (\$4.00) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty two & 67/100 (\$22.67) Dollars (20.00) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Two & 67/100 (\$2.67) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due; for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-one & 33/100 (\$21.33) Dollars,

21.00 Dollars being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 33/100 (\$1.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due).

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th, or before the last day, of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Pen shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid on the said shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said J. H. Meadors and shall pay or cause to be paid, all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said J. H. Meadors

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said bond or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. H. Meadors in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said bond or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to Pen the said J. H. Meadors in hand well and truly paid by the said THE CAROLINA

LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Known as Lot no. 1 in Block "F" as described on plat of Melville Land Company, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Page 97, and being a part of the subdivision of the land bought by the Melville Land Company from L. C. Bolling, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Mrs. Nora Smith by deed recorded in volume 45, page 363, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Less however a small part of said lot conveyed by me to L. H. Gary and P. S. Stone Vol. 70 page 43.
