 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. C. Williamson

 stone; thence S. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 13 feet to stone; thence N. 72 $\frac{1}{2}$   
 E. 9.18 to stone; thence N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 14.40 to pine on road;
