NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said 21st, J. F. Collins

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Peoples National Bank Executors of the Estate of D.D. Davenport all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in O'Neal

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the west side of South Pigger River, the name being nearly all of the tract of land conveyed to me by W. J. McLean on Aug 26, 1885 joining lands of myself, estate of Wm. Bell, Mrs. A. Reese and others. Beginning at a poplar on west bank of said river, and running thence S. 63° 16' W. 16.40 to a stake, about 10 ft. from the south bank of the branch; thence S. 64° 13' W. 5.72 to a stake 3x; thence N. 80° 2' W. 12.36 to a dogwood 3x. thence N. 60° 2' W. 9.51 to an ivy; thence S. 24° 34' W. 28.50 to a stone in the fork of roads; thence with the road 4.25 to a stone in the hill line; thence S. 49° 2' E. 14.00 to a stake 3x; thence S. 10° 2' E. 1.90 to a B. gum at the spring. thence N. 67° 12' E. 18.00 to the river; thence up the meanderings of said river to the beginning containing 194 acres more or less. Also -

a certain piece or parcel of land on the waters of South Pigger River and bounded as follows; on the north and north west by meanderings of long branch and on the east, southeast, south and southwest by land of N. A. Collins and others of South Pigger River, containing six acres, more or less, said land running up long branch to N. A. Collins corner below the mill.
