in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.C. Cauble

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the south side of Oscar Street, beginning at an iron pin one hundred fifty feet from the west side of Bailey Street, and running thence with Oscar Street N. 54-15 W. fifty feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Newton Perry; thence with his line S. 30 W. one hundred twenty-five feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54-15 E. fifty feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of Andrew Long; thence with his line N. 30 E. one hundred twenty-five feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by Narnie Brown by deed dated August 18, 1919 and recorded in Book 45, page 612.
