at the rate of eight per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Paul E. Bass and Lucy P. Bass as Trustee for James K. Bass in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....

Bounded the Eastern half of lot no. 10 as shown on plat of West End Land & Improvement Company, recorded in R. M. C. Officers for Greenville County in plat book A page 153 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Chicora Avenue, joint corner of lots 10 and 9 and running thence with Chicora Avenue 50 feet in a northerly direction, thence with line of lot no. 11 S. 79 W. 75 feet, thence across lot no. 10 in a southerly direction 50 feet to line of lot no. 9, thence with said line N. 79 E. 75 feet to beginning corner.
