Leyle Sealed and Cancelled on 13th day of July 1931#8987in consideration of the sum of \$1000.00 Dollars to me.....securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of \$1000.00 Dollars to me.....in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leyle Mercantile Companyall that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Ward Line of the City of Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Lawton Ave.

Beginning at an iron pin on Lawton Avenue fifteen feet from the South-West corner of lot number Seven (7), thence $272\frac{1}{2}$ E. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake fifteen feet from the South-East corner of said lot number 7; thence N. $18\frac{1}{2}$ E. 45 feet to a stake ten feet from the Southeast corner of lot number six (6); thence N. $72\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake on Lawton Ave. ten feet from Southwest corner of lot number six; thence with said Lawton Ave. S. $18\frac{1}{2}$ W. 45 feet to the beginning corner, being same lot conveyed to H.K. Powers by J. O. Lawton, Jr. by deed dated August 1909, recorded in Val. 4, page 586 in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County and conveyed to me by said H.K. Powers by this deed dated October 7, 1914, recorded in said office in Val. 26, page 429.
