C. for said property in plat Book 9, page 77, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a stake on the White Horse Road 53 feet south of the corner of lot no. 63 and running thence in a westerly direction 217 feet to line of槐树, thence with his line S. 10-15- E. 30 feet to stake thence in a northerly direction 140 feet to point on White Horse Road; thence with the White Horse Road 20. 11 E. 00 feet to the beginning corner.
