in the full and just sum of Eight hundred and eight (\$808.00)

Dollars, to be paid November 1, 1923

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, and its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, or the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.F. Roe, All that certain piece, parcel, tract or plantation

of land lying, and being situate in State and County aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township, on Mountain Creek Road, adjoining lands of T.E. Seago, Q.A. Greene, Roberts and others, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the line of Q.A. Greene and Roberts and running N. 58-3/8 W. 20.90 to pine in edge of Mountain Creek Road; thence with said road N. 60 E. 10.90 to pin in edge of Road; thence S. 27-3/4 E. 18.30 to the beginning corner, and containing Ten acres, more or less, as per survey made by G.A. Ellis, Surveyor, March 10, 1921. It being a portion of a tract conveyed to W.H. Roberts by deed from Q.A.-Greene bearing date November 20, 1908 and recorded in Vol. 15, page 481.
