of land situated, lying and being in the City of Greenville in Ward #2, County and State aforesaid on the East side of Rowley Street, having a frontage of fifty-five (55) feet on said Street and a depth of One hundred ninety-two feet and seven inches (192' 7"), and being Lot #9 on plat of the Stone Land Company made by J.E. Serrine May 21, 1910 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", pages 337-342. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me this day by Charles E. Robinson, and this mortgage is given as a part of the purchase money.
