until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest on the same rate as principal; and a portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W.D. Workman his heirs and assigns*

All that certain lot of land situate near the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and on the East side of Florida Avenue, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin in said Street, which iron pin is one hundred and five feet North of the intersection of Gordon Street and is the Northwest corner of the lot conveyed to Charles G. Eidson by the Cyclone Starter and Truck Company, September 7, 1920 and running thence with Florida Avenue N. 9-15 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-13 E. 210.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 9-15 E. 105 feet to Northwest corner of Eidson lot; thence along Northern line of Eidson lot S. 71-13 W. 210.3 feet to an iron pipe in Florida Avenue, the point of beginning, containing one-half acre, more or less; and being a portion of the property conveyed to the Cyclone Starter and Truck Company by Eliza T.
