at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about two and a half miles from Greenville Court House on what is known as Summit Drive and designated as tract no. 11 as shown on plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 170, and having the following meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a pipe corner of tract no. 10 on Summit Drive and running thence with Summit Drive S. 24. 52 W. 643 feet to bend in said drive, thence continuing with said drive S. 38. 38 E. 100 feet to bend in said drive, thence continuing with said drive S. 62. 51 E. 232 feet to bend in said drive, thence continuing with said drive S. 34. 0 E. 129 feet to branch or creek, thence down said branch as the line to another branch, thence up this other branch as the line to the corner of tract no. 10, thence with the line of tract no. 10 N. 73. 20 W. 560 feet to beginning corner. This tract contains 9.75 acres more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to me by J. L. Childs and Lucian M. Earle by deed dated November 29, 1921, and recorded in R. M.
