 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. E. Geer his heirs and assigns

All that certain parcel or lots of land situated, lying and  
 being on Birnie Street in ward #5 of the City of Greenville  
 County and state aforesaid, and described as follows to-wit:  
 Beginning at an iron pipe on corner of Birnie Street  
 and an alley, extending from said street and running  
 thence with said Birnie Street N. 60 W. 54.25 feet to iron pipe  
 corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of lot No. 4 S. 30.19 W.  
 114.7 feet to iron pipe on line of lot No. 7; thence with line of  
 lot No. 7 S. 60 E. 54.25 feet to alley first named; thence with  
 line of said alley N. 30.19 E. 114.7 feet to the beginning corner  
 and being known and designated as lots Nos. 5 & 6 as  
 shown on plat recorded in Plat Book "E" page 125.
