A. D. L. Barlesdale, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said *A. D. L. Barlesdale*

My one fifth interest in all those three certain lots or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in the County and state aforesaid, City of Greenville, known and designated as Lots 1, 2 and 3 of the Hayne and Miller property as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton, December 1919, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit; Beginning at an iron pipe on Irvine Street and running thence S. 21° 23' W. one hundred seventy-seven and three tenths (177.3) feet to iron pin corner McBee Avenue and Irvine Street; thence S. 70° 30' E. three hundred thirteen and three tenths (313.3) feet to corner wall at corner of Church Street and McBee Avenue; thence N. 19° 30' E. one hundred seventy-six and nine tenths (176.9) feet to stake; thence N. 70° 27' W. three hundred seven and four hundredths (307.04) to beginning corner.
