at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by
these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said E.J. Tate, All that tract of land in the County and

State aforesaid, containing 99- $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, beginning at a stone, north side of Old Glassy Mountain Road, N.M.; thence with said road to pin in fork of old road; thence S. 7 E. 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ to R.O. 3xom; thence S. 20 E. 11- $\frac{1}{2}$ to R.O. 3Xom, gone; thence S. 45 E. 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ to stake in branch; thence N. 77- $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 12- $\frac{1}{2}$ to Chestnut, gone, S. 83 E. 12.70 to stake 3Xnm; thence N. 11 E. 27 on line of Tract No. 2 to the beginning corner.
