for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said William Elliott

according to the terms

of the said bond

and also in consideration of

the further sum of Three Dollars to us the said T. L. Smith and W. L. Smith

in hand well and truly paid by the said William Elliott & Robert Gage, Receivers as  
 aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and bythese Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said William Elliott & Robert Gage,  
 Receivers as aforesaid:

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate  
 lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of  
 Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, on the east side  
 of Main Street in Greer, and having the following metes  
 and bounds, to wit: Beginning on an iron pin in the  
 center of Main Street and running thence S. 85-40-E. 218.5-  
 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 7-15-E. 77 feet to an iron pin,  
 thence N. 82-45-W. 227 feet to an iron pin in the center of  
 Main Street, thence S. 1-20-E. 77 feet to the beginning corner.  
 Being the same property conveyed to T. L. and W. L. Smith  
 by C. Inman, Master for Greenville County.

And it is agreed by and between the said parties, that the said  
 mortgagors T. L. Smith & W. L. Smith their, executors or administrators,  
 shall and will forthwith insure the house and building on said

And it is agreed by and between the said parties in case of default in  
 any of the payments of interest or principal as herein provided for, the  
 whole amount of the debt secured by this mortgage shall become due  
 and payable at once.

And it is further agreed, that said mortgagors, their heirs and  
 assigns, shall pay promptly all taxes assessed and chargeable  
 against said property, and in default thereof, that the holder of  
 this mortgage may pay the same, whereupon the entire debt  
 secured by this mortgage shall immediately become due and  
 payable, if the mortgage shall so elect.
