All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and above 2 miles from Inman, S. C., and known and designated as Lot no. 1 according to a subdivision and plat of the William Durham Estate, made by W. P. Morris on December 1 and 4, 1936, containing 57 acres, more or less, and having the following lines and courses and distances as shown by said plat, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in line of the P. C. Durham road, at southeast corner of Lot no. 2 on said plat, and running thence along the line of Lot no. 2, N. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 36.50 to stake; thence S. 55 E. 18.25 to stake; thence S. 5-30 W. 36.00 to stone; thence N. 5-6 W. 17.80 to the beginning, and being a part of a tract of land conveyed to William Durham by Marcus Durham by deed recorded in the R.
