SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said M. L. Littlefield

Dollars, to be paid as therein stated

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually 30th day of May 1923

until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for the attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jerome Farmer

All that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being
in the town of Greer, State and County aforesaid and having
the following meters and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a
stake at the corner of South Miller street and Hubert street
and running with said South Miller street 188 1/2 feet on
Hubert street adjoining lands of Mrs. Emma Westmoreland
and being the same lot conveyed to L. H. Littlefield by William
P. Potter, Exor. and Bertha P. Allen Executrix of P. C. Potter
deceased, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Vol. 17 page 368.

Also all that other piece parcel or lot of land
adjoining the above described property and having the follow-
ing meters and bounds: Beginning at a stake at the corner
of lot bought by P. C. Potter from Phos. Keating on South
Miller street and run thence west of South fifty-three
thence on line parallel to Hubert street one hundred
thirty-three and one-third feet to stake, thence parallel
to South Miller street fifty feet and to beginning corner.
