WHEREAS, I, the said Fannie L. Scott
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to
Minnie R. Sadler, as Guardian for James and Mary Sadler
in the full and just sum of Six Thousand Dollars, to be paid

January 28th 1923 (see)

with interest thereon from this 10th day of November 1922, at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten percent, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, on said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage, is in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Fannie L. Scott SEE SATISFACTION
RECEIVED THIS MORTGAGE SATISFIED IN FULL JAMES AND MARY SADLER HERETO ATTACHED
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said.

Minnie R. Sadler as Guardian
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said.

Fannie L. Scott
in hand well and truly paid by the said Minnie R. Sadler as Guardian

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Minnie R. Sadler as Guardian all of that lot of land
on River Street adjoining lots of Walker and Berry in the city and County
of Greenville South Carolina and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on
the west side of River Street at the corner of the Berry lot and run thence with
said street N. 1. 45 E. seventy four feet to a stake on said street at Walker's corner;
thence S. 71 W. 316 feet to a stake; thence S. 19 1/6 E. 69 feet to a stake; thence N. 71 E.
288 feet to the beginning. This deed is made subject to a right-of-way conveyed
to G. D. Walker Dec. 19, 1914 reference to which is hereby made.

Also that certain tract of land situate in Easley Township Pickens County, South
Carolina, between the Old Pickens Road and Georges Creek, being a part of the
old Easley place containing twenty-nine and one-half (29 1/2) acres more or less,
and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the old
Pickens Road at Dave Burns corner and running thence with said road N. 32.25-
W. 700 feet to an iron pin in center of said road; thence S. 50.35-W. 1743.6 feet to a
stake on the bank of Georges Creek; thence down said creek with its meanders
745 feet, more or less, to a stake on the bank of said creek at the Dave Burns
corner; thence N. 52.15-E. 1954.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of old Pickens
Road, the beginning corner and being the same land conveyed to Walter
L. Scott by W. H. Griffin.

Also all that other tract of land adjoining the above containing forty-
eight and one-half (48 1/2), acres more or less, less one-half acre
reserved for the Easley family grave yard and described as follows:
Beginning at an iron stake in Old Pickens Road at the corner of the
above described tract and running thence with said road S. 31.30-E. 446
feet to stake in road leading from Pickens road to Easley Road;
thence S. 15-W. 162 feet to stake in last mentioned road; thence with
said road S. 36.15-W. 207 feet to a stake; thence with said road S. 13.40-W.
295 feet to a stake; thence with said road S. 32.10-W. 438 feet to a stake;
thence with said road S. 8.30-W. 277 feet; thence with said road S. 1.90-W.
205 feet to stake on Easley Bridge road; thence with said road S. 50.50-W.
101 feet to center of Bridge over Georges Creek; thence up the meanders of said
creek about 1817 feet to corner of the next above described tract of land;
thence along that line N. 52.31-E. 1954.5 feet to the beginning corner and
described in Deed recorded in office of the Clerk of Court for Pickens
County in Vol. 22 Page 248.
