computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on the amount due

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. H. Braskeys

All that piece parcel or lot of land being known as Lot #14 of Block "B" of the subdivision known as Sterling Annex, and being located just beyond and south of the city limits of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid: plat of the same being recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County in Vol. 8 of plats, at page 11.

The description of the said lot is as follows: beginning at a wooden peg on the south side of Sterling Street 200 feet from the southwest corner of Sterling and Maloy streets, thence with Sterling Street N. 23-10 W. fifty feet to the northeast corner of lot #15, thence with lot #15 S. 67-0 W. 157.77 feet to a point being a common corner of lots 15, 7, 6 and 14; thence with line of lot #6 S. 23-30 E. fifty feet to a point, being common corner of lots 6, 5, 13 and 14; thence with line of lot #13 N. 67-0 E. 157.77 feet to the point of beginning on Sterling street.

This is the same lot conveyed to me, the said Thomas Long, by Thomas F. Parker, my deed dated March 3d, 1921, and recorded in said R.M.C. office in Vol. #71 at page 385. This mortgage is second to a mortgage which was executed by me to B.A. Fraser Oct. 4, 1921, and which was assigned to the said B.H. Braskeys, and is still open for \$500.00.
