thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference

assigns forever, all and singular That certain
piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying
and being in Greenville County, state aforesaid,
all that piece parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the state of South Carolina
and in Greenville County on the west side
of Greenville, about two miles from Greenville
Court House, S. C. and near the Monaghan
Mills, designated as lots 13 and 14 on plat of
New Hope, fronting one hundred and
Twenty (20) feet on Cobb street and having a
depth of one hundred and Thirty-two (32)
feet, more or less, plat recorded in the R. M. C.
office in and for Greenville County in Plat
Book A. at page 307. These being the same
two (2) lots conveyed to me (formerly Josephine
Turner) by William Goldsmith by deed dated
November 27th, 1911 and recorded in the R. M. C.
office in and for Greenville County in Vol.
47 at page 247.
