in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION its successors and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward 4 of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 18 of Oakland Heights, property of W.C. Cleveland as shown on plat recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, at page 147, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Lewis Street, joint corner Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with line of Lot No. 17, N. 33-49 E. 129.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner lots Nos. 12 and 18, and running thence with line of Lot No. 12, S. 64-34 E. 53.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 32-34 W. 131.4 feet to an iron pin on Lewis Street; thence with Lewis Street N. 62-19 W. 56 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described lot being one of the lots conveyed to F.W. Symmes, W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower by W.C. Cleveland by deed dated the 16th, day of April 1914, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 16, at page 153 and subsequently the interest of F.W. Symmes having been conveyed to W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower by deed dated the 11th day of August 1915, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 36, page 70, and being the same lot conveyed by W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower to H.T. Marchbanks by deed dated the 26th, day of April 1920 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 56, page 547, and further being the same lot conveyed to me by H.T. Marchbanks by deed dated the 26th, day of April 1920, and recorded in Vol. 48, page 274 in R.M.C. Office.
