SEND GREETING:

in the full and just sum of Eight Hundred and thirty six and 20/100 Dollars, to be paid thirty days after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid 1921

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of less than one percent of amount besides all costs and expenses of collection; to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to 1921, the said Mary D. Preig,

in hand well and truly paid by the said N. S. Powell, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. S. Powell,

All those four lots of land in the County and State aforesaid, being Lots Nos. 13, 14 and 15 of Block "D" and Lot 520, 4' of Block No. 2 of Melrose Heights, according to a survey recorded in Plat Book "A" page 157, in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County.

I acquired title to the above described four lots under the will of W. J. Goodlett, deceased, on file in Apartment 159, File 2, Probate Court, Greenville County, South Carolina, and my deed from N. S. Powell dated September 26, 1922.
