with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal. and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. G. Leatherwood

All that certain lot of land situate lying and being in the
County and State aforesaid and in Greenville Township and
being known and designated as Lot no. 2 as shown on
plat of property of J. B. Bruce and Dr. A. White, which
plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Plat Book 6 at page 58 and having the
following meters and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on an unnamed street
joint corner of Lots 3 and 2 and running thence
with said unnamed street S. 9-006. 29 feet and
4 inches to a stake corner of Lot no. 1. thence
with line of Lot no. 1 N. 67 1/2 E. 145 feet to a stake
in line of Lot no. 10. thence with line of Lot no. 10 N. 9 1/2
W. 34 feet to a stake corner of Lot no. 3. thence with
line of Lot no. 3 S. 73 1/2 W. 143 feet to the beginning
corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to me
by J. G. Leatherwood.
