All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, two miles from Greenville Court House, having the following metes and bounds to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on South side of David Street at corner of lot of J.N. Campbell and running thence with his line 190 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with the alley S. 41-30 E. 95 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot of Batson's; thence with Batson's line N. 48-30 E. 190 feet to iron pin on David Street; thence with David Street N. 41-30 W. 95 feet to the beginning.

Known as Lot No. 74 of the Hammett lands, less however, a part of the above described lot with a frontage of 47-1/2 feet and a depth of 190 feet in which a life estate was conveyed by me to M.L. Campbell and J.N. Campbell by deed dated March 19, 1921, recorded in Volume 97, page 356.

The lot intended to be covered by this mortgage has a frontage of 47-1/2 feet and a depth of 190 feet and has a three room house thereon.

This is the same lot conveyed to me and J.D. Bowling by W.G. Serrine by deed dated June 20, 1906, recorded in Volume SSS, page 420, the said J.D. Bowling having later conveyed his interest therein to me by deed recorded in Volume 8, page 474.
