Mills property, said plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", page 223, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Hamilton Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 18 and 19 and running thence with line of lot No. 18, S. 16-15 W. one hundred and forty-five (145) feet and six (6) inches to an iron pin; thence S. 77-45 E. fifty (50) feet, one and one-half (1-1/2) inches to an iron pin joint rear corner lots Nos. 19 and 20; thence with line of lot No. 20, N. 16-15 E. one hundred and forty-two (142) feet to an iron pin on Hamilton Avenue; thence with Hamilton Avenue N. 73-45 W. fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner.
