promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any

kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That We the said W.A. Julien and C.F. Putman

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better

securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ida C. Austin

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Judson Mills property and being known and designated as lots Nos. 2 and 3 on plat of property of M.C. Jimison, deceased, recorded in R.M.C. Office for County and State aforesaid in Plat Book E., page 161, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances: Beginning at an iron pin on road to Judson Mill, joint corner of lots 1 and 2, and running thence along line of lot No. 1, S. 42-30 W. 200 feet to point in line of lot No. 3; thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 53-55 E. 140 feet to corner of lot No. 4; thence along line of lot No. 4, N. 42-30 E. 200 feet to point on road to Judson Mill; thence along said road N. 53-55 W. 140 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lots of land conveyed to C.F. Putman and F.G. Mauldin by R.A. Jones by deed dated November 5, 1923, and recorded in Book 97, page 557, the undivided one-half interest of F.G. Mauldin having been conveyed to W.A.
