 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. G. Huff

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in.....Township,
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

About three and a half acres of land lying in the south side
 of the Prairie Road, running from the point near Monaghan
 Mills to a point near Cunningham Store, containing
 24.11 acres, more or less, and having the following lines
 and bounds: Beginning at an iron post on the south side of
 Parker Road, N. E. of J. G. Huff's place, and running thence with
 line of H. L. Huff and J. G. Williams S. 32-35-W. 25-47 chains,
 more or less, to stone in line of J. G. Huff; thence with
 line S. 32-35-E. 71-51 chains to corner of triangle conveyed by
 J. G. Hair to C. C. Vardell; thence along his line S. 82 E. 3.40 chains
 thence still with C. C. Vardell's line N. E. 55 E. 32-05 chains to stake
