all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in near Judson Mills, known  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as lot No. 15 in Block C on plat recorded in  
office of R. M. C. for said County in Plat  
Book C, page 209, having a frontage of  
80.98 feet on the west side of Flosselad  
Avenue, with a depth on side of 255.56  
feet, and on the other of 464.45 feet  
and running back in parallel lines,  
being the same lot conveyed to me by  
W. H. Shannon by his deed dated May  
31, 1923, recorded in Book 82, page 103. This is the first mortgage on the  
above lot.Also the other lot of land in the
