 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Olive A. Peace,

that certain piece and lot of land situate lying and being

 the North side of East Stone Avenue in the block east of
 Estipanith St. and known as lot no. 16 on plat made by J. H.
 Southern and recorded in C. M. C. Office for Greenville County
