WHEREAS, I, C.T. Thomason

in and by A certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Five hundred (\$500.00)

Dollars, to be paid Jan'y. 1st, 1924

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T.R. Goldsmith, his heirs and assigns forever, All that piece,

parcel or tract of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, situated on the  
North side of public road leading from Mountain Inn to Fork Shoals, having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone in the Fork Shoals Road running S. 72 W. 2.3 to stone; thence S. 13-1/2 E.  
16.22 to a stake; thence S. 81-1/4 E. 15.20 to a stake; thence N. 22-1/2 W. 9.84 to a stake;  
thence N. 18-1/2 W. 3.71 to a stake; thence N. 64-1/2 W. 13.40 to the beginning corner, contain-  
ing Twenty and 40/100 acres, more or less.
