TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, J. L. Bussey SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. L. Bussey

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

Melville C. Westervelt as Trustee in the full and just sum of Three Hundred Thirty-three and 34/100 (\$ 333.34)

Dollars, to be paid as follows: one-fourth in six months, one-fourth in twelve months, one-fourth in eighteen months and one-fourth in twenty-four months

with interest thereon from Date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. L. Bussey in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Melville C. Westervelt as Trustee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said J. L. Bussey in hand well and truly paid by the said

Melville C. Westervelt as Trustee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Melville C. Westervelt as Trustee

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 16 of Block "E" of the subdivision known as Augusta Court, as shown on a plat of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Plat Book "F", page 124, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at Northeast intersection of a 30 ft. Street and Augusta Court, and running thence with said 30 ft. Street N. 47-10 E. 152.5 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 16 and 21; thence with the joint line of said lots N. 37-57 W. 61.1 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots Nos. 15 and 16; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 52-03 W. 154.1 feet to Augusta Court; thence with Augusta Court, S. 39-33 E. 74 feet to the point of beginning.
