Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

All that certain lot of land situate on the East side of Jackson Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and beginning on said Street at the corner of the property of Elizabeth Cleveland and runs thence with Jackson Street S. 21-3/4 W. 21 feet and 6 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 67 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-1/2 E. 20 feet and six inches (or more) to Mrs. Elizabeth Cleveland's line; thence with her line N. 67-3/4 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by Walter W.
