sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charlie Dumit

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the Earley Bridge Road, known as
a part of lot no. 5 on plat of
property of Cooper and Yawn, recorded
in office of R. M. C. Greenville
County in Plat Book F, page 77. This
lot is known as lot "D" on map
no. 7 of Highland near the city
of Greenville, South Carolina, having a
frontage of fifty (50) feet on the
north side of Gordon Street with
a depth in parallel lines of two
hundred (200) feet.
