SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *J. V. Brown*, the said *L. V. Brown*

in and by *J. V. Brown* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of *Twenty-eight thousand two hundred dollars*, *28,000.00* Dollars, to be paid on or before the date when the *10th* Series of the *First Mortgage Note*.

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if

J. V. Brown fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said *J. V. Brown*

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION,

All that piece, parcel of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City limits of the City of Greenville, being all of Lats nos 60, 61 and 62 in the 2nd division of the Marion Early Property known as Marion according to Plat made by City Planner Perry, dated July 6, 1920, recorded in Plat Book "E" page 273 in office of C. H. C. for said tract and having the following boundaries and distances according to said plat beginning at a stake in the western boundary line of said sub-division on the north side of Laurel Avenue, corner of lot no. 60 and thence with Laurel Avenue in a southeasterly direction 12.3 feet to stakes, corner of lots nos 63, 1 corner with line of lot no. 63 in a northeasterly direction 12.8 feet to stakes, thence in a northeasterly direction 12.3 feet to stakes, northeast corner of said sub-division thence with western boundary line in a northeasterly direction 124.3 feet to the beginning. Subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth in the deed from *A. L. Poore* to me, dated June 17, 1921, recorded in Plat 63, page 157.
