with interest thereon, from J. R. McCoray at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid J. R. McCoray

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear J. R. McCoray

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. G. Arnold

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in the state and County aforesaid in Block 1, Precinct No. 1, near the Town of Greer and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on Main Street corner of lot #3 and runs thence N. 83-30 E. 60 feet to a stake on said street, corner of lot #20, 57, thence N. 6-30 W. 206.1 feet to a stake on alley, thence N. 76-30 W. 61 feet to a stake, back corner of lot #3, thence N. 6-30 E. 201.7 feet to the beginning corner being all of lot #4 in Block 1 on a plat of land known as "Bassett's Place" same lot conveyed to me by W.
