SEND GREETING:

computed and paid until paid in full

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time paid due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That, the said H. E. Stone

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan & Trust Company

Farmers Loan & Trust Company, a Corporation, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Oak
Lawn Township, about seventeen miles from the City of Greenville, having the following
metes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by W.J. Riddle, bearing date February
25th, 1918, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone 3x on about ten or twelve feet, more or less East of the present line
of the Augusta Road; said stone being on the line of the old abandoned bed of said Augusta
Road, and running thence along said abandoned bed and along line of land belonging to S.V.-
Chandler N. 28° 40' W. 8.99 chains to a stone 3x on; thence S. 76½° W. (crossing the present
line of the Augusta Road) along line of a tract of land belonging to G.W. Stone 28.10 chains
to a stone 3x on on line of land belonging to I.P. Jordan; thence along line of last
mentioned land S. 31° 45' E. 11.05 chains to a stone 3x on on joint corner of land belonging
to Ioton and land belonging to J.B. Stoddard; thence along the Stoddard line N. 76½° E.
26.82 chains to stake on tract of land conveyed by George W. Stone to A.B. Sims; said stake
being about ten or twelve feet, more or less, West of the present line of the Augusta Road;
thence along said Sims line N. 5½° W. (crossing said Augusta Road) 1.88 chains to the
beginning corner, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less; this being the same
tract of land heretofore conveyed to me, the said H.E. Stone by George W. Stone; this
mortgage being given to secure the payment of a portion of the purchase money therefor. There
is no other lien or encumbrance upon said land or any part thereof by mortgage, judgment or
