Johnson's corner at corner of lot sold by me to M.R. Langston and running thence with Langston's line S. 76 by E. 170 feet to stake; thence S. 9-30 W. 60 feet to stake; thence N. 170 feet to stake on old White Horse Road and thence with said road N. 9-30 E. 60 feet to the beginning*
