in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, South Carolina

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the north side of East Washington Street between Broadus Avenue and Manly Street, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of East Washington Street, 140 feet from the northwest corner of Manly and Washington Streets, and running thence N. 15-51 E. 87 feet 6 inches to an iron pin, thence N. 41 W. 96 feet to an iron pin on corner of lots 2, 7, and 6; thence S. 17 W. 137 feet 6 inches to an iron pin on Washington Street. thence S. 73-03 E. along Washington Street, 80 feet to the beginning corner and being known as Lot 4, Block 2, Boyce Addition, according to plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 90.
