 payment of interest and then to payment of principal, at the  
 rate of.....eight.....per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly.....annually,  
 and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I.....have further  
 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal pro-  
 ceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold  
 and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....H. P. McGee

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in.....

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,.....

w. the South Side of Court Street, described as follows:  
 Beginning at a point on South Side of Court Street.....at distance of 108.4 feet west from the South West  
 corner of Willow and Court Streets and running  
 thence with Court Street N. 89-13 W. 34 feet to a pin,  
 thence S. 141 W. 130 feet to a pin, thence in an  
 easterly direction in a line parallel with Court  
 Street 54 feet to a pin thence N. 141 E. 130 feet to  
 the beginning. Being the same this day conveyed  
 to me by H.P. McGee, and their mortgage is  
 given to secure the payment of part of the

 by J.P. Drake to the mortgage given by said J.P. Drake to The Carolina Loan and Trust Company  
 for thirty eight hundred dollars, so that I now hold the second mortgage, and The Carolina  
 Loan and Trust Co. holds the first mortgage.
