Lot No. 17 being on the southeast corner
of Q. M. C. A. and Center Streets, fronting 50 feet on
south side of Center Street, with a depth along
Q. M. C. A. Street of 153 feet, with a depth along its
eastern side of 151 feet, and being 50 feet
wide at rear.
Lot No. 16 fronting on the south side
of Center Street, with a depth of 151 feet along
